- ACT 20-22 and completion (C- or above) of 12th grade Math course beyond Algebra 2
- CAASPP/SBAC Standard Exceeded
- CAASPP/SBAC Standard Met and completion (C- or above) of 12th grade Math course beyond Algebra 2
- Weighted high school Math GPA of 3.5 or above and completion of Senior year math course
- Weighted high school Math GPA of 3.5 or above and 5+ years of Math or Quantitative Reasoning
- Weighted high school GPA 3.7 or above

STEM level General Education math course

CATEGORY 2

- CAASPP/SBAC Math Standard Met and 4 or more years of Math or Quantitative Reasoning
- Weighted high school Math GPA 3.0 or above and completion of Senior year math course
- Weighted high school Math GPA 3.0 or above and completion of 5 or more years of Math or Quantitative Reasoning
- Weighted high school GPA or 3.7 or above
- Weighted high school GPA of 3.5 or above and 4 or more years of Math or Quantitative reasoning

General Education math with supported instruction. Early Start is recommended (a summer class prior to starting)

STEM level General education math course with supported instruction. Early Start is recommended

CATEGORY 3

- Weighted high school Math GPA 3.3 or above
- Weighted high school GPA 3.0 or above

All Majors
